Safety Vests on Marine Terminals

NON – APPROVED SAFETY VESTS



PCMSC Rule 650

An approved high visibility reflective vest must be worn at all times within a marine terminal or onboard a vessel. With the employer's approval other articles of clothing which provide equivalent high visibility reflective protection or are ANSI/OSHA approved may be worn in place of the vest.

Grey, Brown, Black and other dark materials are not considered a high visibility color and can not be worn on the the terminals.
